## **Wycliffe Touring Dinner Theatre Available Early to Mid March**

Wycliffe Touring Dinner Theatre presents a cultural meal and a play that portrays the power of God's Word to transform lives. *Sunong* is a play about a Buddhist boy in an isolated language group in Southeast Asia and a Canadian linguist whose desire is to translate God's Word into Sunong's mother tongue. *Sunong* is a fictionalized story based on true events. To tell the real story would endanger lives.

To host the play, a church has to provide a space 60 X 80' with a 13' min. ceiling, 265 chairs, housing, reservations, promotion, and a few volunteers. The theater brings everything else, from kitchen, lighting, sound, stage, actors, and cooks. The cost is covered by a love offering.
